Admission Procedure for Foreign Students

International Islamic University Chittagong (IIUC) welcomes international students and makes every effort to assist them in getting admitted in its academic programs. In this regard, special consideration is given to the students from SAARC countries, South and South-East Asia.

Application procedure

Foreign students can apply through online at IIUC website: www.iiuc.ac.bd for admission in any related discipline of Bachelor or Master Programs. Every candidate must fulfil the admission requirements (mentioned on the website: https://www.iiuc.ac.bd). They are advised to follow application procedures available on the IIUC website. Required documents during admission are: two stamp size color photos, certified true copies of all academic records and photocopy of passport.

After verification and clearance from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangladesh (As per the circular of UGC) offer letter for admission may be issued. VISA must be obtained by the incumbent before entering Bangladesh. During the study period at IIUC, VISA may be renewed with assistance of International Affairs and Student Welfare Division (IASWD).

Scholarship

The student can apply for scholarship after admission. It may be confirmed subject to the availability of any sponsor.

Residence Facilities and living expenses

Residence hall facility is available. We have multistoried halls at our Campus, Kumira. The monthly expenses for accommodation and meals may be \$100 per person. But the initial registration fee for residential facilities is \$100.
